### 1. Rough 2D 4/4+ diamonds + major, 0-9, attention to position and vulnerability

Responses:

2H Pass or correct, then any bid over 2S is to play

2S/2NT Asking in hearts/spades:

Step rebids are 0-2/3 min/3 max/4 min/4 max/5 min/5 max

3C Range ask – 3D min, 3H/3S max

Raises pre-emptive

3H/3S 6 cards, highly encouraging but NF

4H/S To play

2H/2S 5 card suit + 4+ card minor - 2NT asks for minor, 3C pass or correct, 3D sound raise, 3H P/E

2NT 5-5+ minors

3H/3S Pre-emptive

Double of 1NT by passed hand or strong NT = 4 major + 5 minor
