Investing in vital local electricity networks in your area.

We're writing to inform you about some work that we'll be carrying out in your area. It's part of a £20 million pound plus investment we're making to the electricity network in your area to ensure our customers continue to receive a safe, secure and reliable supply of electricity, both now and in the future.

From Monday 27 January 2025, our contractor Balfour Beatty will be digging in the roadway starting on York Place between Prince of Wales roundabout and the junction of Oatlands Drive. This will involve closing two of the three lanes and installing a one-way system. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Traffic Management will be set up on the evening of Sunday 26th January in advance of the works.

Once completed, work will then start on a 60 meter section along Otley Road and continuing over Prince of Wales roundabout to the start of York Place. Multiway traffic management will be in place for the duration of these works, which are expected to take around four weeks to complete.

You may experience some temporary disruption, including parking restrictions and traffic management measures while we carry out the work. We understand this can be inconvenient, and we'll make every effort to minimise the impact on your daily routine.

Our teams will be working to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible and we'll keep you informed on our progress. These essential upgrades will benefit customers in the Harrogate area by improving the reliability and resilience of your vital local power network.
