This will be a “Build Your Own Bridge Congress”. Pay just for bridge and refreshments. As an alternative you may order a meal separately on the day. There will also be prizes for each stage of the Congress.

Saturday 13th June – Multiple Pairs 12:00-19:00
(1st session qualifier followed by 2 finals)

Sunday 14th June – Multiple Teams 11:00-18:00
(1st session qualifier followed by 2 finals)

On both days there will be a break of 45-60 minutes between the qualifier session and the finals.

All sessions will be 24 boards and are Green Pointed.

Entrants may play for one day only on either day or both days.

Entry fees are £35 per player for 1 day or £65 if playing on both days.

This includes tea, coffee & sweet treats throughout the event with free parking in the hotel grounds.

On **Sunday 14th June there will be a Relaxed Pairs** event.

This is for players ranked no higher than NGS Jack.

The event will run from 13:30 to 17:30 with a short break.

The entry fee is £15 per player which includes tea or coffee.

Or £30 If you take afternoon tea in the break.
